



Dual Enrollment NEW Funding Application Instructions: www.GAFutures.org

The NEW Dual Enrollment Funding Application is now available on www.GAFutures.org.

Dual Enrollment program pays for tuition, mandatory fees, and book costs toward your dual enrollment classes **up to 30 semester hours**. It does NOT pay for supply or lab fees. Once you exhaust your 30 hours, you must decide if you want to use the HOPE Grant for eligible classes or pay out of pocket.

The financial aid application must be completed before you can register for classes each semester and prior to the college fee deadlines in order for your tuition, mandatory fees and books to be paid. You will be expected to provide a hard copy of your funding completion prior to registering each semester.

Follow the directions below and apply now prior to the deadline! Note that you will only have to apply once a year, but note the payment deadlines for each term below. Failure to complete the funding application will result in you being responsible for payment of your classes.

- FALL Semester deadline to apply is August 1st
- SPRING Semester deadline to apply is December 1st
- SUMMER Semester deadline to apply is April 1st

You should have already created an account with your high school. Ask your High School Counselor if you have forgotten your login information.

NOTE: When creating your personal profile, you must be very accurate when inputting your full legal name, birthdate and social security number. Check it carefully before you save your because inputting that number incorrectly will cause your application to be rejected and you will have to re-submit it.

To complete the funding application, please follow these steps. Go to the website: www.gafutures.org
Everyone will choose the online dual application!

1. Scroll down to the bottom right of the site under News You Can Use banner under the Trending tab.
2. Choose the Dual Enrollment Funding Application for 2020-2021.
3. The next page has the blue quick link in the middle that takes you to the application and instructions; click this link and sign in to your account.
4. Make sure you choose the correct high school and college when completing this application or your funding will not be processed.
5. Once you've completed the application, **print a copy for your records and one to submit to your college dual enrollment advisor** to assist with completing the process. Email your counselor to let them know you have done your application.
6. When applicable, pay any supply or lab fees not covered by this funding prior to the fee deadline each semester in order to remain in college classes.
